Nationalism in Western Nations

Students will apply their knowledge of tactics used to nationalize Germany and Italy when creating a **propaganda piece** to support something they are a fan of.

Students will apply their prior knowledge of rebellions to a **revolutionary role-playing card game** where they act as various community members with conflicting motivations deciding whether to revolt and establish a new nation or to remain under foreign rule.
