1. Description



Create a list of the visual qualities of the work with your partner/group.

- Describe the shapes you see.
- What colors are used?
- If this object is or has a painting on it, what or who is in the painting?
- What or where is your eye drawn to? Why?

2. Analysis



Discuss these questions with your partner/group:

- Where is this object from?
- What materials is this object made of?
- Why do you think the artisan used those materials to create this artifact?
- What was this object used for?
- Do we use objects similar to this artifact today?

3. Interpretation



Discuss about the original owner(s) of this artifact.

- Would you say this object is in good condition?Why or why not?
- What can you infer about the original owner of this artifact? Were they wealthy? What might they have done for a living?
- What clues/evidence do you see to support your ideas?
- Why did the artist create this piece the way that they did?
- Do you think this object was made specifically for the owner? Why or why not?

4. JUDGMENT



Each person in the pair or group shares their final thought.

- Did you like the piece? Why or why not?
- Does your partner/group agree or disagree with your opinions? Why or why not?
- What do you think about your partner/group's points?
 Are they well supported? Is it causing you to rethink your own perspective?
